Experiences and impressions from the JCSE in Tirana, 2008.

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Our preparation before this course (1st year & 2nd year of master)

- Both of courses had attended a full course (of one semester) of SE during bachelor studies.
- In that course we have taken the basic knowledge of SE.
- But the students of 1st year of master, had few difficulties because they had not yet attented some subjects like Compiler Construction, or UML.
- Nevertheless, students preparation was almost sufficent to attend with success the JCSE in master studies.

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What we had during the lessons

- Very well structured lessons.
- Good description of the main topics of SE
- Good reference materials.
- Concrete work (assignments, metrics suite, examples-TechWare, XCTL).
- Very good interaction with the lecturers during the lessons, but lacked their presence for solving the assignments.

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The used literature

- The slides were very useful, but the students needed to read the complete materials beside the slides.
- One of the most used books (of H. Balzert) was in german language and could not be used by the students.
- It was nessecary to search in the internet for extra materials especially for the assignments.

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The experience with foreign professors

- First time for us to attend a course with foreign professors.
- In the begining, the students were reserved in making questions and even giving the answers.
- Later, these difficulties were overcome due to the lecturers ability to communicate with us.
- The way the lecturers explained the lessons was interesting, filled with examples and concrete situations from personal experience.

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The experience with foreign professors

- The lecturers made maximal effort in the way that the lesson was understood by everyone.
- They kept alive our couriosity during the lessons by conducting them in question-answer way.
- Very good communication with the students which allowed us to make questions in a free way.
- The lecturers never discouraged us even when the answers were wrong.

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The difference between our professors and foreign ones

- The Albanian professors don't interact very much with students during the lesson.
- It was a new and a very good experience for us the way the lecturers conducted the course of SE.
- During the lesson, the slides had many questions demanding for our answers and opinions.
- This made the students stay focused, and more interested in the lessons.

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Following the lessons in english

- It was the 1st time for us to attend a whole course in english.
- Some difficulties with the language, deeper concentration was required.
- Sometimes the students were "shy" in making questions and giving the answers.
- Despite the problems, the general opinion of the students is that it's good to have the subjects in english.

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The assignments

- There were four assignments during the course.
- They were interesting and concrete, referring to the theoretical part of the lessons.
- We had enough time for solving the assignments
- The most difficult one was the first, as it was given before the lessons started.
- The assignments kept us engaged with the subject even after the course completed.

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The organization of the groups

- Mean number of members in a group was four.
- Not the same leader every assignment.
- For some assignments the members worked individually and then joined the work.
- For some others, the work could not be divided individually, so they were solved in cooperation.

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The exam

- The final exam was long, but we had all the time to answer all the questions.
- The questions covered all the topics of the lessons.
- The questions were short, and the key concepts were asked.
- The exam contained both theory questions and exercises.

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Conclusions

- It was a very interesting and a well structured course.
- A very good experience for all the students.
- We had a good explanation of key concepts of SE (theory and examples).
- Very good interaction with the lecturers.

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Few suggestions

- Longer duration of the course.
- The possibility of concluding the course with a full project in SE.
- It would have been interesting to integrate this course with another which covers the project management phases in SE.
- We would be very grateful if this course will continue in the future.
